Equipment like laptops, docking stations, projectors and security cameras supplies were severely impacted during the pandemic. Wait time for most of these items have now been reduced from 1.5 years to a couple of months.



Solar Projects at Various Sites:

On Aug. 3rd several community members joined to celebrate a commemorative projects ribbon cutting, which recognized the achievements and goal of TUSD's sustainably mission in creating a districtwide cumulative 5.3 Megawatt energy producing solar portfolio system. Further to this, the solar project is expanding onto its next marked sites; North School and the Clover/TLC which will have a planned completion of Feb. 2023

District Wide Safety Projects/Plan:

Just a few weeks after National Safety Month, Tracy USD staff in tandem with City of Tracy PD were tasked to review all schools and improve on their facilities safety conditions and amenities. The result of several days of review and auditing, assisted in creating a projects lists which will cover several areas needing improvements. These facility improvement projects, will focus on addressing items such as; fencing, adding cameras, modernizing intercom and fire alarms systems, updating door hardware, and creating forced entries into campus administrative offices. The improvement projects will require a multi-year approach in completing and obtaining state approvals where required.

Preschool, Transitional Kindergarten, and Full-Day Kindergarten Facilities Project:

This school year, we welcomed the new program within various campuses locations. In future, TUSD plans to expand and modernize its existing facilities to accommodate the new growth.
